Guidelines for Abstract Submission:

- ⤴ Abstract (200-300 words) final submission date **4th Jan 2013**
- ⤴ Accepted abstracts will receive notification by **1st Feb 2013**
- ⤴ Required format is MS Word Times New Roman 12pt,
single spacing, with indicative bibliography; all to fit on one side of A4
- ⤴ Abstracts to be submitted electronically to s.j.parry@leeds.ac.uk with
<your name - ABSTRACT - title> as the filename.
- ⤴ Book of Abstracts will be emailed to participants in advance, with hard copy at registration.

Programme: Papers must be prepared in English. The Programme Committee are very keen to encourage contributors to submit early versions of abstracts or papers for comment and for advice on language issues. We are happy to receive abstract submissions any time from now.

Publication: Final papers may be considered for publication in a range of journals associated in various ways with BPSA and its members, in accordance with normal submission guidelines, e.g: *Sport, Ethics and Philosophy; Acta Universitatis Carolinae - Kinaanthropologica*; etc.
